**ORDER TO ESTABLISH MORATORIUM ON VENDING, PEDDLING
AND SOLICITING PERMITS**

I, Joseph L. Harris, the duly appointed Emergency Manager for the City of Benton Harbor, Michigan (the "City"), pursuant to the power and authority granted by Act 4 of the Public Acts of Michigan of 2011, being MCL 141.1501 et seq (the "Act"), do hereby resolve and order as follows:

WHEREAS, Section 19(dd) of the Act provides the Emergency Manager with authority to exercise all police powers of the City; and


WHEREAS, the City is reviewing regulations applicable to vendors, peddlers and solicitors in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

1. A moratorium prohibiting the granting of any permit or other approval to allow vending, peddling and soliciting in the City is hereby established for a period of thirty (30) days or until such time as a new ordinance regulating vending, peddling and soliciting is adopted and effective.
2. That all prior resolutions, ordinances or acts of any kind of the City in conflict herewith are and the same shall be, to the extent of such conflict, rescinded.

3. This order shall be effective immediately.
